

## **Sabert Corporation Scope 3 Inventory**

The following Scope 3 emissions have been calculated in accordance with the GHG Protocol: Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and reporting Standard. The GHG Protocol Standard includes 15 categories of Scope 3 GHG emissions that companies are required to report.

Material categories for Scope 3 GHG emissions reporting were determined using the GHG Protocol Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard. Emissions are consolidated from entities over which Sabert has operational control. Categories reported are all provided in the minimum boundaries. Sabert partnered with an industry-leading data reporting platform, whose leading climate database for granular emissions measurement and expertise supported the data provided below.
